HVO-ADA Foundation Volunteer Fellowship

The HVO-ADA Foundation Volunteer Fellowship supports HVO's oral health projects and volunteers who seek to improve the quality and availability of oral health education around the world. This fellowship is available through a generous grant from the American Dental Association Foundation (ADAF).

Dentists who are HVO members with confirmed HVO assignments may apply for funding up to \$1,500 to defray some of their travel-related expenses. A qualifying dentist is (a) a dentist who is a first time HVO volunteer and/or (b) a dentist who graduated from dental school within the last five years.

To be considered for the HVO-ADAF Volunteer Fellowship, the volunteer should let the [Volunteer Placement Coordinator](#) know of their interest prior to their scheduled assignment. A committee will review requests.

If approved for funding, the volunteer will receive a reimbursement check after they have returned from their assignment and submitted their itinerary, as well as a completed Volunteer Feedback Survey (VFS).

As a reminder, additional costs that are not covered by this fellowship are tax-deductible if you are a US citizen.
